SINCE 1992, IDRF HAS SUPPORTED 30+ MEDICAL VANS IN 16 STATES ACROSS INDIA

Presently, IDRF is supporting medical services for people living in abject poverty and unhygienic conditions through medical vans in the slums of Aurangabad, Maharashtra, and remote hilly villages in Arunachal Pradesh and Assam. The mobile clinics provide OPD services (with nominal token fees), medicines, free immunization, micro-surgeries (eye and ear), de-addiction counseling, AIDS awareness programs, etc. These healthcare services are available to 25,000+ people each year.
