
EMPOWERING MOBILE EDUCATION FOR UNDERSERVED CHILDREN: BRIDGING THE LEARNING GAP



Door Step School (DSS) is a nonprofit organization in Maharashtra, India which takes education to the doorsteps of children from marginalized communities in the cities of Mumbai and Pune. One of DSS' programs is the School on Wheels (SOW) which serves as mobile classrooms and libraries equipped with audio-visual facilities, teaching-learning material, and more. These buses visit locations where setting up conventional centers is not feasible. Each bus covers four locations in a day, offering numeracy skills and language literacy to these children.

Presently, DSS operates 14 such buses in Mumbai (5) and Pune (9) reaching over 5,000 children annually. IDRF is supporting 3 SOWs in Pune. These SOWs focus on improving learning levels, and overall development of children, and increasing parental involvement in their children's education, paving the way for a brighter future.
