FOUNDER'S MESSAGE


Dear Friend.

SUPPORT EDUCATION FOR **50 UNDERPRIVILEGED GIRLS**

Your contribution can provide education underprivileged children, mobile healthcare in slums, hilly, and tribal areas, and support the participation of women and marginalized communities in rural governance. It can also fund safe water supply through rainwater harvesting, biogas units and tree planting to combat climate change, micro-loans for small enterprises, and toilets and bathrooms to end open defecation.

PLANT 10,000 TREES TO ADDRESS CLIMATE CRISIS AND SUPPORT LIVELIHOODS IN TRIBAL VILLAGES



A gift to IDRF's tree-planting initiative helps address climate change and supports the livelihoods of families in rural communities. With over 21,000 trees already planted in 100 villages of Chhattisgarh and Gujarat, we've seen how fruitbearing trees provide income while cleaning our air and supporting ecosystems. This initiative has mobilized community members for aftercare and use of a mobile app to track the survival and growth of the saplings.

We are seeking your support to continue our climate initiative program to plant more fruit-bearing and medicinal trees for protecting the environment as well as helping the villagers economically.



\$1000 can plant 400 trees (\$2.50 per tree) and fight climate change for a sustainable future.



In Gujarat's Kutch district, women walk miles daily to collect water, carrying heavy loads that strain their health and take time from their families. IDRF's Water Wheels program lightens this burden, making daily water collection easier and safer.

In Gujarat's Kutch district, rainfall is low and erratic, and women and girls walk 3-4 miles each day in rural areas to fetch water for household use. Carrying heavy loads that strain their health and take time away from their families. This drudgery of carrying water can be reduced using inexpensive containers on wheels with a capacity of 12 gallons. IDRF is seeking your help to provide water wheels to the local self-help groups to be distributed to women who carry water every day. Each container can be used by multiple families.

PROVIDE MOBILE MEDICAL SERVICES FOR THE POOR IN REMOTE HILLY, TRIBAL AND SLUM AREAS



Since 1992 IDRF has supported 35+ Mobile Health Clinics in 17 states across India for people living in poverty and with poor access to health care. IDRF is raising funds to expand Healthcare Vans to more areas to help the needy patients.

Our medical vans provide a range of OPD services like medicine, vaccines, micro-surgeries, de-addiction counseling, community health awareness programs, etc. These vans benefit more than 30,000 people each
